

Health and Safety Rules for the Modular Shooting Screen System (MSPS)

Supervision and Responsibility

- Safe use of the MSPS is the responsibility of the range officer or the designated instructor.
- During individual training, the user may simultaneously act as both the shooter and the person supervising the exercise.
- In the event of a hazard, the person in charge must immediately stop the exercise by issuing the command “Cease fire”.

User Requirements

- Use of the MSPS under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or substances impairing psychophysical fitness is prohibited.
- Every participant must strictly comply with the shooting range rules and the instructions of the person in charge.

Safety Zones

- Only persons taking part in the exercise may remain in the immediate vicinity of the screens.
- Bystanders must remain outside the designated safety zone, at least several meters behind the firing line.
- It is strictly forbidden to enter the line of fire or move between the shooter and the target.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Mandatory: safety glasses, hearing protection, protective gloves.
- Recommended: footwear with non-slip soles and reinforced toe caps.
- For multi-level configurations, a safety helmet is recommended.

Transport and Assembly of Components

- Always lift and carry the modules with two people, using proper lifting techniques to protect the spine.
- Throwing components or transporting them in a way that could cause damage is prohibited.
- Protective gloves must be worn during assembly.

Pre-Exercise Inspection

- Check that all components are dry, stable, and undamaged.
- Ensure that the modules have been properly connected and secured against tipping over.
- If there is any doubt about the technical condition, the exercise must be stopped.

External Conditions

- Do not use the MSPS during strong winds, storms, heavy rainfall, or in conditions of limited visibility.
- The ground around the structure must be stable and dry – avoid slippery or uneven surfaces.

Emergency Procedures

- If a screen tips over, immediately stop the shooting and remove all persons from the danger zone.
- Every participant should know the location of the first-aid kit and the rules of first aid.
- In the event of an accident, immediately notify the person in charge and emergency services.
